



## **CFBL Bat Regulations for PREP AND JR. PREP DIVISIONS ONLY**

**No composite barrel bats unless it meets BBCOR Standard will be allowed. A BESR composite barrel is not allowed in the CFBL. A composite barrel is being defined as one that has a metal shell, but a woven composite of fibers on the inside of the barrel portion of the bat. Non-BBCOR Composite handled bats are okay. ALL Drop -3 bats must be BBCOR. Pretty much everyone knows what a composite bat is.**

### **Any infractions will have the following consequences:**

If while at bat a player is found using a composite bat, the defensive team shall record an out, the player loses that at bat, and the bat shall be removed from the dugout. If the bat is found to be illegal immediately after a ball is put in play (before the next pitch), the at bat shall be nullified and the defense shall record an out, the batter shall be removed from base and the bat shall be removed from the game. The offensive situation will return to it's it's last previous setting prior to the ball being put in play and play shall resume from that point unless the out was the third out which will retire the side. If the batter reaches first base on a walk or hit by pitch, the awarded base shall be nullified and the defense will record an out, the batter shall be removed from base and the bat shall be removed from the game as long as the illegal bat is identified prior to the next pitch. The offensive situation will return to it's it's last previous setting prior to the awarded base and play shall resume from that point unless the out was the third out which will retire the side.
