## St. Louis Baseball Forever League: Website Content Policy

The below policy is applicable to both the STLBFL League Website and its associated individual Team Websites.

HARASSMENT: We welcome individuals of all different backgrounds, orientations, and views, so this is our most important rule: Threats, abuse, hate-speech, personal attacks, and harassment will not be tolerated.

VULGARITY AND MASKED VULGARITY: We ask users to refrain from using vulgar language in any of our Website content. Masked Vulgarity is using cuss words and trying to "mask" them with other symbols or letters, so the word isn't spelled out. Content of this nature will be removed.

Content that transmit or facilitate distribution of content that is libelous, harmful, antagonistic, slanderous, invasive of privacy, in violation of the rights of another person, unintelligible, pornographic, obscene, defamatory, threatening, harassing or abusive are prohibited. STLBFL prohibits any Website content that denigrates any individual, group or culture.

The STLBFL Executive Council (EC) reserves the right to remove any Website content that violates the Website policy, and retains the right to remove content that it deems, using its own standards, offensive or in conflict with the interests of the League.
